## Beyond School. We're Family.

**A**lthough Most Holy Trinity School and Academy makes it our business to educate young students and help each student be successful in high school and beyond, our faculty and staff are an extension of each student's family. Our faculty advocates for each student, and partners with parents to support and encourage each child to be their best self. This is in keeping with our holistic approach to education: that



students' educational, social, spiritual and developmental needs are identified, met, and nurtured. Our students begin each day at 8:00 a.m. with all-school prayer and breakfast and end each day in our extended day program at 6:00 p.m.

Family is such an important part of who we are at Most Holy Trinity Catholic School and Academy that our K-8<sup>th</sup> students are placed in mixed grade "school families" that offer leadership opportunities for our Academy students and allow for all students to know and care for one another. Every week at the all school mass, you will find our school families praying together. Our "school families" also have special lunches and monthly activities.

The socio-economic circumstance of our students effects what emotions they bring to their classroom and more importantly, how they learn. As such, many of our students arrive at Most Holy Trinity Catholic School and Academy at or significantly below grade-level with

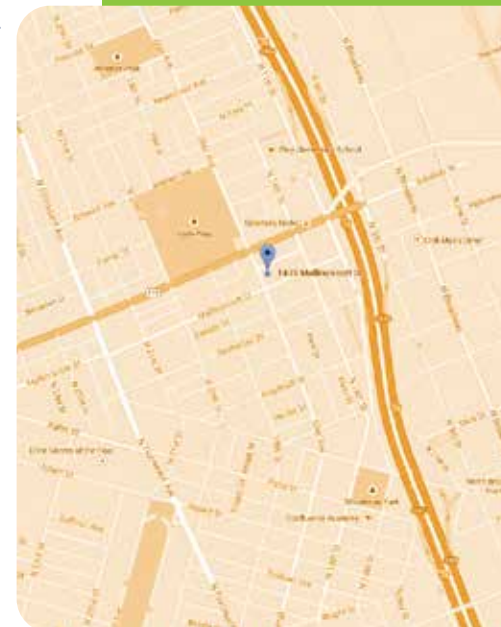
many social and emotional needs. The majority of our students are living at or below the poverty level in single-parent households. 100 percent of our students qualify for free and reduced lunch. Many students are moving homes multiple times in a school year and/or their primary caretaker changes. Knowing this, and identifying and understanding our students needs both academically and socially, our class sizes are small and our dedicated teachers are proactive. We serve two hot meals and snacks daily. We have a counselor and a Mercy Kids social worker on campus and available to work with families and students beyond their educational needs, like family.

We have seen significant achievement with our students from grade-level to grade-level in standardized test scores. It is in our middle school academy program, that the achievement gap is finally bridged so that our students can attend the high school of their choice. Our Academy students (6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>) take enrichment classes including study skills, art, and business courses, and experience an extended school day (5:30 p.m.) and school year (through June).

Most Holy Trinity Catholic School and Academy is in it for the long term, too. Once our students move on to the high school of their choice, our graduate support personnel, principal, and faculty continue to work with each family to ensure that our students are thriving in their new environment, both academically and socially.
